Conference Privacy Notice

Effective date of this privacy notice: Nov 1st 2021

Your privacy and the protection of your personal data is important to us. This Privacy Notice explains the type of personal data Takeda may collect from you and how we use it.

Takeda is a globally operating group of companies. The Takeda enterprise includes the parent company Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited, and its affiliated entities (together "Takeda" or "We"). Your data will be collected and further processed by Takeda Pharmaceuticals Croatia d.o.o., Ivana Lučića 2a, 1000 Zagreb, Croatia. We may process the following types of personal data such as name, address, email and other contact information, job title, professional background and qualifications, for the purpose of confirming your role in the care of patients with SBS-IF (Short Bowel Syndrome - Intestinal failure) and to better understand your needs in caring for them.

When you participate, we may also automatically collect technical information such as your e.g. Internet Protocol (IP) address, etc.

Our use of your personal data as described above is based on your consent to be registered at SBS-IF Expert meeting and receive the follow up survey and SBS-IF expert meeting recording.

We may share your information with third-party hosting providers, IT service providers, with whom we collaborate to fulfil the above purposes. We may also share your information with Takeda affiliates and subsidiaries.

The sharing of your personal data may involve transfers to other countries. The data protection laws in these countries may not provide the same level of protection as your home country. Takeda will put in place safeguards to adequately protect your personal data in connection with such transfers, including contractual protections for which you may request additional information from us.

We keep your personal data for for up to 12 months after participation in the conference at which point all data will be securely deleted, unless you provide your consent for us to contact you for other purposes in which case we will store your personal data for as long as we maintain a business relationship with you or you withdraw your consent.

You have the right to request access to, rectification and deletion of your personal data or that its use be restricted. If you would like to make a request to exercise any of these rights, please contact us privacyoffice@takeda.com

If you have a complaint about the way your personal data is being processed, you also have the right to contact the Data Protection Authority in your home country, where there is one.
